## 2017 TOURNAMENT SERIES

### JANUARY 7<sup>TH</sup> • BOYD LAKE

#### LOCATION

Boyd Lake State Park  
3720 N County Road 11-C • Loveland, CO 80538

#### EVENT LOCATION

Marina Boat Ramp Cove

#### PARKING

Marina Boat Ramp Lot; Overflow into Swim Beach Lot

#### HOURS

Registration/Check-In Tent will open at 5am. All anglers must register/check-in before going on the fishing course. Once anglers are registered/checked-in they can go on the course to select their pre drilled hole. Holes are first come first served. **The tournament starts at 8am and ends at 12pm (noon).** Anglers are not allowed to drop their lines in the water until the 8am start. Anglers can use electronic depth finders to check depth before the event starts.

#### WEIGH-IN/LIMITS

The official weigh-in scale will be located just outside of the Mr. Heater Warming Tent located on the edge of the fishing course. All fish must be weighed live and weighed immediately after they are caught. Each angler can weigh their legal limit of each species. All fish weighed must be legal catches and must meet size requirements put forth by Colorado State Parks and Wildlife. All fish including rough fish can be legally weighed.

#### WALLEYE

Each licensed angler can weigh their legal limit of 5 walleye which all must be a minimum length of 15" and of the 5 walleye only 1 can be over 21".

#### BASS

Each licensed angler can weigh their legal limit of bass which all must be a minimum length of 15".

#### WHITE BASS

Each licensed angler can weigh legal limit of 5 white bass.

#### TROUT

Each licensed angler can weigh their legal limit of 4 trout.

#### PERCH

Each licensed angler can weight their legal limit of 20 perch.

#### CRAPPIE/BLUE GILL

Each licensed angler can weigh their legal limit of 20 crappie/blue gill.

#### ICE ADDICTION SPECIFIC RULES

Anglers can bring as many rod/reels as they like and can move around to open holes as much as they like but are restricted to the use of 1 hole and 1 line at a time.

Each angler can use legal methods of take and legal bait for that area and or body of water. Bow fishing, spear fishing, and snagging are illegal during the event. All fish must be caught from the gill plate forward.

Ice shelters or covers are not allowed during the event. Anglers must fish in the open.

Ice Addiction staff will pre-drill all holes and anglers are required to fish in these pre-drilled holes. There will be 20% more holes than entrants so anglers have the opportunity to move around.

Anglers must attend their line at all times. Unattended lines are subject to disqualification.

Anglers must follow all rules and laws of both the Park and Colorado State Parks and Wildlife. Park passes are required on all vehicles entering the park.

All ALCOHOL must meet requirements set forth by the park. NO DRUG USE of any kind is permitted during Tournament hours.

#### NOTES

A warming house is provided by Mr. Heater. It will be set up on the edge of the course for all anglers to use prior to and during the event to get warm. There will be FREE Coffee and Johnson's Corner Cinnamon Rolls while supplies last.

#### RESCHEDULING OF EVENT

In the event of poor ice conditions at Boyd Lake on Jan. 7th, this event will be moved to Wellington Lake on Jan. 7th, located just east of Bailey Colorado.

In the event of extreme weather on Jan. 7th this event will be rescheduled for Feb. 18th at Wellington Lake.

Event rescheduling can happen up to 2 hours before the start time of the event.
