LOCATION

Pueblo State Park

LAUNCH SITE

South Shore Marina

HOURS

Mandatory rules meeting at 5:45am on May 20th at the South Shore Marina. At least 1 team member must be present at this meeting.

Tournament hours are from 7am to 3pm.

Mandatory off the water 5/19/17 at 5pm. Boats/anglers must be off the water by 5pm on April May 19th and may not return until the event begins on May 20th.

WEIGH-IN

The official tournament weigh site will be located at the South Shore Marina. Once the event is over anglers are encouraged to load their boat and drive to the weigh-in station located at the group picnic area near the boat launch. Once at the weigh station one angler will take the fish to the scale and the other will pull their truck/trailer forward and park it.

IF YOU CHOOSE TO NOT FISH UNTIL THE END OF THE EVENT

The weigh-in station will be in operation from 8am and remain open til the end of the event so if you wish to stop early you can weigh your fish at any time. Once you pull off the water you can not return.

Walleye Bag and Possession Limits/Size Limits

The daily bag limit for Walleye at Pueblo is 5 Walleye's per angler. Each Walleye must be a minimum of 18" and of the 3 Walleye you may only have 1 greater than 21". During The Walleye Insanity Tour we limit each team to only having 8 fish in possession at one time.

As a team of licensed anglers each team can have up to 8 fish in the boat. Once you place your 8th fish in the boat you are done for the event and must head to weigh in. **THIS IS A NO CULL EVENT.** Once a fish is placed in your boat it can not be released.

NOTE

The official measure board for this event is the EGO Measure Board. **MAKE SURE ALL FISH BROUGHT TO THE SCALE ARE WITHIN LEGAL LENGTHS AND LIMITS.** Bringing in a Walleye less than 18" or more than your possession of Walleye greater than 21" will result in an immediate disqualification.

BOUNDARIES

Anglers may fish anywhere their boat will float but must follow are boating regulations including no boating zones, buoys, and no wake zones.

SPEED LIMITS

Pueblo reservoir has a 40MPH speed limit. If you are caught breaking this speed limit or acting irresponsible or in a dangerous manner it will result in immediate disqualification. Tournament staff as well as Pueblo State Park Park Rangers can make this decision and all decisions are final.

ANS INSPECTIONS/TOURNAMENT INSPECTION

ANS Inspections/Tournament Inspection- all boats must go through and pass the mandatory ANS inspection provided by Pueblo State Park Staff. Tournament staff will also be checking live wells, safety equipment (life jackets, throwable's, fire extinguisher, horn or whistle), and lights.

A State Park Pass is required in enter this park.
