# 2019 WALLEYE FISHING TOURNAMENT

## DAY EDITION • JUNE 29<sup>TH</sup>

### AT PUEBLO RESERVOIR

#### LOCATION

Pueblo State Park • 1 N Marina Rd., Pueblo West, CO 81007

#### LAUNCH SITE

South Boat Launch Boat Dock

#### HOURS

**Mandatory rules meeting** 6:00AM on June 29th prior to launch. All anglers **MUST** be present at this meeting.

Tournament hours are from 7AM to 3PM.

Boaters can launch their vessels after the rules meeting but must stay in the no wake buoys near the ramp until the 7AM launch time. Anglers choosing to walk the shore must stay in the south boat ramp parking lot until 7AM before walking to their destination. Once 7AM arrives anglers that are fishing from shore, kayaks, float tubes or other small vessels can drive to the North Shore Marina Parking Lot to launch and or walk from there. **THE SOUTH SHORE BOAT LAUNCH PARKING LOT AND THE NORTH SHORE MARINA PARKING LOTS ARE THE ONLY TWO LOCATIONS SHORE ANGLERS AND HAND LAUNCH BOATS ARE ALLOWED TO LEAVE FROM.** All trailered boats must launch from the South Shore Boat Launch.

**Mandatory** – Boats/anglers must be off the water by 5pm on 6/28 and cannot return until the event begins on 6/29.

#### WEIGH-IN

This is a **DIGITAL EVENT**. At the rules meeting each angler will be given a Tightline Outdoors Walleye Insanity specific ruler. This ruler will be numbered to match each angler. After a legal fish is caught, and the measure and release process is done, anglers are to text in their video to the weigh master. Once the weigh master confirms that the video is clear and accurate they will text back confirming the catch. When you catch a legal fish you are to lay the fish on the measure board with the head touching the angled head board. You then lay the fish flat. Take a video of the head of the fish touching the head on the measure board and then **CLEARLY** show a video head to tail and where the tail touches the measurement. Once you have that clearly videoed you then show yourself in the video and then show the release of the fish. All Walleye **MUST** be a minimum length of 18" to measure and count in the event. Anglers can submit as many 18" and longer fish videos as they wish. **To clarify, for a fish to count in the event, the video must CLEARLY show the following:**

- Head of the Walleye touching the head board on the measure board.
- Must show the tail on the measurements.
- Must Show the angler who caught the Walleye
- Must Show the release

If the video does not clearly show all these things then your fish does not count in the event.

The Measure Board is marked with 1/4" bars. You will measure to the 1/4". For example... if a Walleye is exactly 18" then it is registered at 18". If the Walleye measures 18-1/8" then it is rounded up to 18-1/4". In the event of a tie the fish that was submitted first will win the tie breaker.

#### BOUNDARIES

Anglers and vessels must stay out of the Pueblo Marina Slips. Boaters must follow all boating regulations including buoys and no wake zones.

#### SPEED LIMITS

Pueblo has a **40MPH Speed limit for boating**. If you are caught breaking this speed limit, or acting irresponsible or in a dangerous manner on shore or in a vessel, it will result in immediate disqualification. Tournament staff as well as Pueblo State Park Rangers can make this decision and all decisions are final.

#### ANS INSPECTIONS/TOURNAMENT INSPECTION

All boats must go through and pass the mandatory ANS inspection provided by Pueblo State Park. Tournament staff will also be checking coolers, trucks and boats' live wells and for safety equipment (life jackets, throwable's, fire extinguisher, horn or whistle, lights).

**A State Park pass is required for your vehicle to enter this park.**

#### SPECIAL NOTES

Being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will remain cause for immediate disqualification from the tournament. **NO DRUG OR ALCOHOL USE PERMITTED DURING THE EVENT.**

This event is open to all ages. Any participant under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian sign the waiver. No one under the age of 16 is allowed to operate the vessel during tournament hours.

ONLINE REGISTRATION WILL CLOSE JUNE 28TH AT 5PM.

All **EVENT UPDATES** (changes, reschedules, etc) will only be provided to participants via e-mail and Facebook. Please be sure to provide an e-mail address you frequently use for registration.

#### PRIZES

**Prizes are based on a 100 angler participation.** If the 100 angler participation is not met, then prizes will be adjusted by percentage according to full field percentages and pay out will not go as deep into the field.

#### RESCHEDULE/CANCELLATION

In the event that there are less than 30 anglers pre-registered the Thursday before the event at 5pm, the event will either be 1) rescheduled 2) cancelled or 3) minimized prize list will be issued. Reschedules/Cancellations can happen at any time up until the start of the event. In the event of extreme weather, causing unsafe travel or unsafe reservoir conditions, this event will be rescheduled. All tickets will automatically be transferred to rescheduled dates/locations. Tickets are non-refundable. Only in the event that Tightline Outdoors cancels the event in its entirety will the tickets be fully refunded.
